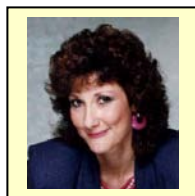

- **Tot Shabbat**, with Reb Jason, his talking guitar, and his puppets! Starting Fri., 9/11 at 7pm!

### Introducing our New Office Staff!

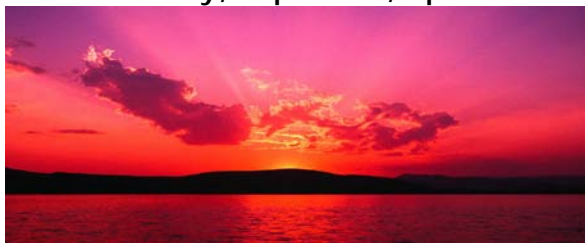

With that, I'd like to wish you all a Good *Yom Tov*, a sweet and happy New Year... a year filled with happiness and blessings as we continue this journey together as a family.

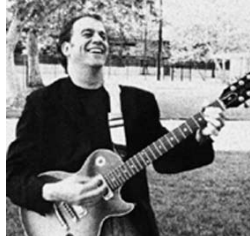
